



Enviro - PVC Composite Blinds

Main uses:

PVC commonly known as Vinyl is a composite plastic with excellent environmental stability and durability, used in a range of products. It is extensively used world wide in the production of Venetian blinds, also shutters and Vertical blinds.

Properties:

Due to its co extruded formulation it is very stable unlike natural products, does not twist or warp even under extreme temperatures and UV radiation. It is resistant to moisture and humidity and does not absorb water, and it is environmentally friendly with no hazardous organisms in it. Solid colours and wood tones make it look and feel like natural and painted timber but with longer lasting quality.

Its hard wearing surface and flexibility make it easy to work with, it cuts and punches extremely well and with the ability to supply it in long lengths it is economical for manufacturing.

Testing:

Testing has been done and certified for twist and warping, UV resistance and Hazardous environmental substances. PVC can stand temperatures up to 55 degrees with no movement in the slat, and no yellowing from UV radiation.
